The Director of Clinical Education (DCE) is responsible for all aspects of the clinical experiences of students enrolled in the program, including organization, administration, continuous review and revision, planning for and development of locations (with appropriate supervision) for evolving practice skills, and the general effectiveness of the clinical experience. In addition, the DCE will participate in classroom, laboratory and clinical instruction, and will perform departmental and institutional duties as assigned.

Qualifications: Master degree from an accredited academic institution* required. Doctoral degree completed or in process preferred. Graduation from an accredited Respiratory Therapy program; RRT credential and current NYS Respiratory Therapist license (or eligible); a minimum of 4 years of experience as RRT with at least 2 years in clinical respiratory care; to include a minimum 2 years of experience teaching in an accredited respiratory care program either as an appointed faculty member or as a clinical preceptor.
