

Director of Clinical Education, Lynchburg

Liberty University School of Health Sciences, Department of Allied Health Professions invites applications for a Director of Clinical Education/Assistant or Associate Professor for the Bachelor's of Respiratory Therapy Program. The appointment for this 12-month position begins July 2018.

Qualifications

Candidates must have:

1. a master's degree minimum and doctoral degree preferred (completed by June 2018) in respiratory care, health science or health communication, education, leadership, or related fields;
2. a valid Registered Respiratory Therapist (RRT) credential and current state license or the capability of obtaining a Virginia Respiratory Therapist license;
3. a minimum of six years' experience as an RRT, with at least two years in clinical respiratory therapy; and
4. a minimum of two years' experience teaching in an accredited respiratory care program either as an appointed faculty member or as a clinical preceptor.

Candidates with a reputation of achievement in education, demonstrated leadership in respiratory care, an active research program, and active participation in relevant professional associations are preferred. The successful candidate will provide clinical direction and oversight of the program in accordance with fulfilling the requirements for accreditation, assist with program planning and curriculum development, and provide didactic, laboratory, and clinical instruction.

The successful candidate will be expected to work collaboratively with colleagues, deliver instruction, advise students, engage in scholarly activities and engage in University, professional, and community service activities. Ideally, candidates will have experience using course management systems for purposes of instruction and advising. Candidates must be able to support and promote the University's Mission, its full doctrine, and its traditions.
