



**Full Time Faculty Position

The Respiratory Care program in the Department of Health Sciences in the School of Health Professions at The University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio is seeking candidates for a fulltime (12 month) faculty position for a well-established Commission on Accreditation for Respiratory Care accredited program. The Department offers a traditional baccalaureate degree program, an RRT to BS degree completion program and a NEW first professional Master of Science in Respiratory Care degree program.

The School of Health Professions and the Department offer innovative faculty development opportunities that assist faculty members in their own growth and development. The School of Health Professions is an integral part of an exciting health science campus including the School of Medicine, School of Dentistry, School of Nursing, and Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences. The campus resides in the South Texas Medical Center which encompasses five of the major hospital systems in San Antonio. The University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio is a constituent of the University of Texas System. San Antonio is the center of a vibrant educational, medical, economic and cultural community.

**Position expectations include:**

Teaching (traditional and online courses) at the undergraduate and graduate levels, participation in curriculum development and revision, and student advisement and recruitment. Candidates are expected to demonstrate the ability to engage in research and scholarship, service and professional leadership activities.

**Knowledge, skills and abilities required;**

Outstanding face-to-face and on-line teaching skills, to include traditional instruction, use of electronic media and learner management systems, mentoring student projects, student advisement and knowledge of educational principles and methods for use in the classroom, on-line and in clinical settings; testing, evaluation and assessment of outcomes; and familiarly with research methods and design. The candidate must have the ability to work effectively with others, communicate effectively; and demonstrate professional leadership skills.

**Minimum Qualifications:**

1. Master's degree in health sciences or a related field (e.g. biological sciences, education, management or leadership). An earned doctorate in a health care field, education, leadership, management, the biosciences, or a related field from a regionally accredited college or university is preferred;
2. Graduation from an accredited respiratory care educational program;
3. Current credentialing as a Registered Respiratory Therapist (RRT) and eligibility for state licensure in Texas;
4. Evidence of outstanding teaching and leadership skills;
5. Professional qualifications and experience consistent with an academic appointment at the rank of Assistant Professor or above;
6. Clinical experience as an advanced level respiratory therapist;
7. Evidence of active participation in state and/or national professional societies;
8. Evidence of scholarship and/or research success (e.g. papers, abstracts and/or publications).

Academic rank, salary, and tenure or non-tenure track status are dependent on the education and experience of the successful candidate. Review of applications will begin as early as November 1 and the search will remain open until the position is filled. The position is available as early as July 1, 2017.
