

## Assistant Professor, Associate Professor, or Professor

The Department of Respiratory Care at Texas State University invites applications for a tenure-track faculty position at the assistant professor, associate professor, or professor rank for a nine-month appointment with possible summer employment annually. Responsibilities include didactic and clinical instruction.
